Admission Requirements

Minimum qualifications for admission to the Master of Arts in Interior Design include:

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited program in interior design or related design degree (applicants without design backgrounds will be considered for the 3-year program);
- A 3.0 minimum GPA in the last 60 graded semester hours or 90 graded quarter hours;
- Minimum TOEFL score of 550 paper-based or 213 computer based test (international applicants);
- A personal statement addressing the applicant's interest in pursuing the Master of Arts in Interior Design, anticipated career path, and specific areas of research interest;
- Three letters of recommendation written by college level professors or advisors, or professional references that address the applicant's ability for intellectual engagement, creative thinking, attitude, and motivation;
- A written essay or visual evidence that demonstrates creativity;
- All other requirements as outlined by the WSU Graduate School.

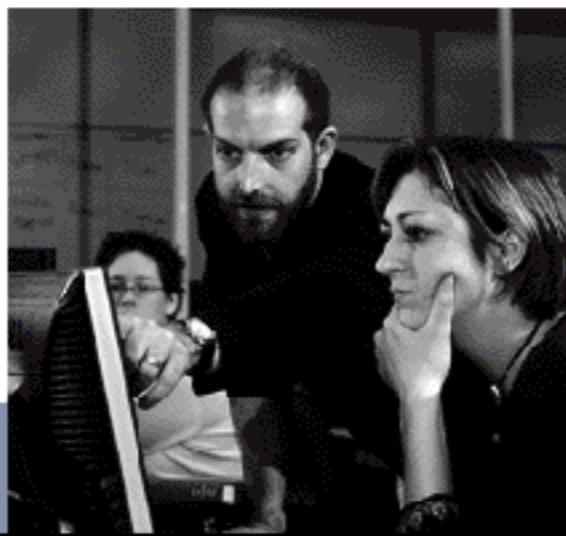
About Washington State University Spokane
