## Master of Science in Architecture

### Admission Requirements

Minimum qualifications for admission to the Master of Science in Architecture include:

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited program in architecture, or related design degree preferred;
- A 3.0 minimum GPA in the last 60 graded semester hours or 90 graded quarter hours;
- Graduate Record Examination scores (while the GRE is not required, it is preferred, especially in cases needing more clarity of academic competence than is evidenced by the applicant's GPA and/or other required application materials);
- Minimum TOEFL score of 550 paper-based or 213 computer based test (international applicants);
- Statement of research interest or focus area;
- Three letters of recommendation written by academic and/or professional references;
- Portfolio of design work or other evidence of creative ability;
- All other requirements of the WSU Graduate School as stated on the application form.
