

Connecting a Mac OS 10.5 Leopard Computer to the Riverpoint Wireless LAN

These instructions will guide you through the process of connecting a MAC OS 10.5 Leopard computer to the Riverpoint wireless network.

Before You Begin

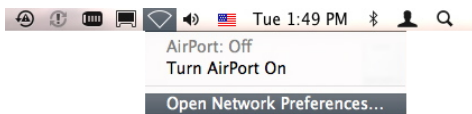
To access the Riverpoint wireless network from an Apple computer, you must have a valid EWU or WSU network ID (NID) and password.

Note: Any device that is connected to the Riverpoint wireless network must support 802.1x authentication. The iPhone does not support 802.1x authentication at this time and cannot be used over wireless.

Note: If you have problems connecting to the wireless network at any time during this process, please contact the lab assistant in the Academic Center Lab.

Connecting to the Riverpoint Wireless LAN

1. Click the Airport icon, and select **Open Network Preferences**.



2. Select **Airport**, and click **Turn Airport On**.



3. Click **Join Other Network** from the Network Name menu.



4. Enter the following information in the screen that appears:

- Type WSU-RP or EWU-RP in the Network Name box.
- Select **802.1X WEP** in the Security menu.
- Type your Network ID from the User Name box.
- Type the password provided in the Password box.



5. Click **Join**. You are now connected to the Riverpoint wireless LAN!
