

## Connecting an Apple Computer to the Riverpoint Wireless Network

These instructions will guide you through the process of connecting an Apple computer to the Riverpoint wireless network. ### Before You Begin

---


To access the Riverpoint wireless network from an Apple computer, you must have a valid EWU or WSU network ID (NID) and password.

**Note:** Any device that is connected to the Riverpoint wireless network must support 802.1x authentication.

**Note:** If you have problems connecting to the wireless network at any time during this process, please contact the lab assistant in the Academic Center Lab.

### Connecting to a Network

---

1. Turn on Airport.
  - Click the Airport icon  , and select **Airport: on** from the drop-down menu that appears.
2. Click the airport icon again, and select **Open Internet Connect**.
3. Click **File**, and select **Leap**. The 802.1x dialog box appears.
4. Type your User Name (Network ID) and password.
5. Select a wireless network from the **Network:** list, and click **Connect**.
6. Open your browser. The Clean Access Authentication screen appears.
7. Type your User Name and password, and click **Continue**. You are now connected to the Internet.
